

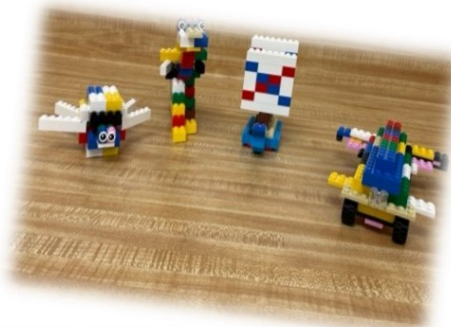

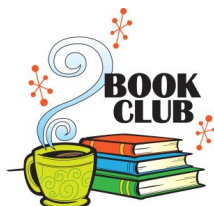

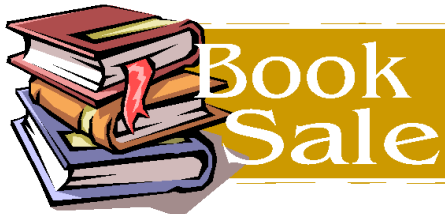
## Friends of the Madison Heights Library
